SPRING 2009 STANFORD ACHIEVEMENT TEST RESULTS
ELEMENTARY FIRST THROUGH FIFTH GRADES**

The following is a summary of 2009 Stanford Achievement Test results. Our students overall have scored very well again this year. North Carolina private schools are required to annually administer a nationally ranked achievement testing instead of the NC end of grade tests administered in public schools. Every student tests differently, and has unique strengths and talents. Some factors that affect test scores are attention span, being well rested or not, illness, test anxiety, etc. Test taking is a skill that improves the more often a student completes them, and is just one indicator of your child's learning in the classroom. Grades, attendance, and social quotient are also important parts of the component for your child's overall success. These factors all work together to provide the whole picture of a student's level of functioning. Each test section gives an indicator of mastery level and where improvements can be made. The grade equivalents and percentiles shown below are a national ranking of all students who were administered the test.
