Expansion Report:

- Candace Definis reported that the WCA modular is ready for delivery, pending permitting approval from the county and some preparatory construction.
- Mary Beth Roth reported that administration is still working toward the goal of a police presence on campus.
- Candace also reported that a meeting about the high school expansion took place on Thursday,
 August 24. The job posting for the new high school principal's position has gone live. Planning
 for a marketing campaign is underway, along with a new logo. Candace asked for support from
 the PTF in sharing the word about the expansion. Jay Peters asked for a single image and
 wording that everyone can share on social media.
